Reuben Hogan is not only involved in all aspects of student life at Carrollton and Banks. He is a paragon for the Jesuit High School community and embraces the Blue Jay spirit in all that he does, from his leadership within the Student Council, his academic prowess, and the spiritual example he sets.

For living out the Ignatian ideal of *Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam* in so many ways, *The Blue Jay* is pleased to name Reuben our **Blue Jay of the Year**.

From his first days at Jesuit, Reuben has been involved. In his senior year, he has served as a leader of the school community as executive aide on the boards of the Student Council and the National Honor Society. He puts forth the Jesuit name through outstanding performances as vice captain of the Debate Team and as a member of both the Varsity Quiz Bowl team and Mu Alpha Theta.

His spirituality is just as spirited, benefiting the community through his work in Campus Ministry. His other forms of service include cleaning up the environment in the Green Club, and tutoring students in the Classics Society, in which he serves as President.

Reuben truly has lived campus life throughout his five years at Jesuit and his service to the school has set up a standard of how one can successfully make the most out of anything to which he puts his mind. As we prepare to leave our beloved Alma Mater, Reuben reflected on his career at Jesuit with insight and humor.

The Blue Jay: What does it mean to you to be chosen as Blue Jay of the Year?

Reuben Hogan: To be chosen is such an incredible honor. It was never my goal to work for this title; I've just been doing what I love and what I think is important. So to be acknowledged like this is honestly one of the last things I could have ever guessed at happening. If anything, the honor is just an encouragement for me to continue doing what I'm doing.

TBJ: What has been your best moment at Jesuit?

RH: Despite the unforgettable times I've had this year, I still think that the best moment was the commemoration of the 50th anniversary of integration. That week was particularly important to me because not all of my Jesuit career had been filled with sunshine. There were times when I felt out of place or separate from the community, but that commemoration gave me the comfort and confidence that there was a greater end in the changing Jesuit. It indicated that there was a genuine care at Jesuit for the concerns that I was struggling with.

TBJ: Do you have a favorite class or teacher?

RH: These favorite or best questions are always so difficult. I have so many favorite teachers and classes. I think my favorite teacher has been Mr. Acy because I had

him back to back for my sophomore and junior years and I spent a good amount of time outside of class talking (or trying to talk) to him. My favorite class has been Calculus BC. There's just something about hearing "EAT DIRT!" at the most unexpected time, then shaking to the point that you can't tell if you're laughing because you don't know if what just happened on the board is math or you're crying because you just don't know what to do. And finally, you look around to see everybody else doing the same thing; that just makes the class so much fun.

TBJ: Where will you be going to college?

RH: I will be attending Washington University in St. Louis to be part of the Danforth Scholars Program there. Liam Fitzgerald and I will both be in the same program and even in the same dorm.

TBJ: What will you be studying?

RH: I'm definitely majoring in biology, but I might double-major in the Classics or Philosophy. I'm not entirely sure about the last part yet.

TBJ: How might you sum up your experience at Jesuit in one sentence?

RH: It's been like living in a second home with first brothers.

TBJ: Out of all the co-curricular activities you have done, which one is the most memorable?

RH: The most memorable activity I've done has been being on the debate team. Debate is an activity that not only changes how you speak but how you fundamentally think, and that is priceless. It helps you understand the logic that is so fundamental in almost every discipline of academics. Debate was the activity which shaped me for everything else. It gave me the disposition to be selected for E-Board and the mind to pursue the activities I did.

TBJ: How did you balance co-curriculars and academics?

RH: Boy, that's a good question. Some days I look back, and I wonder how I balanced it too. I think the most overlooked aspect of finding a balance is finding what's worth a balance. The co-curriculars you do should not be things that you do for others or for a resume. They should be the activities that genuinely inspire you to achieve greater goals and become a better

person. When you find those activities that make you feel that way, you don't mind if you have to sacrifice an hour or two of sleep after schoolwork. You are willing to strike a balance for that which is important to you.

TBJ: How have you been fulfilled most fully as you look back at the past five years at Jesuit?

RH: I think that the most fulfillment I've had at Jesuit has been in realizing my relationships with other guys at this school. I have such a fierce love for Jesuit because of its camaraderie. It was one of the main reasons I decided to attend. When you stay up until 3 a.m. talking with teammates about life, when you stand in the student section throwing flour in the air with the guys next to you, when you are approached by another student for advice, there arises an intense and palpable connection between you and the other people at this school. There is something that you foster which tethers you to Jesuit and which you cherish more than anything else.

TBJ: How would you describe your experience being on the Student Council E-Board this year?

RH: Phenomenal. Everyone on the E-Board holds an incredibly special place in my heart, and being in that group was the true pinnacle of my Jesuit career because it was a time when I was able to collaborate with the others to enact plans and ideas for the betterment of the school.

TBJ: How has the Student Council Cabinet gone this year and what are your hopes for it in the future years of Jesuit?

RH: The Student Council Cabinet did well for its first year. It wasn't exceptional, but I think that our Cabinet delegates really got the ball rolling on establishing discourse about the culture at Jesuit. Although some roles need to be fleshed out, I generally hope to see the Cabinet become a ready resource for students to initiate discussion about diversity, unity, and service from the standpoint of our school's influential leaders and to see it become an origin for movements to more positively shape Jesuit culture.

TBJ: Any funny times that you especially remember?

RH: Too many! The best was when the Greek III class threw a birthday party for Mr. Acy last year on the last full day of school. It wasn't really his birthday. He refused to tell us an actual day, so we just celebrated it at the end of the year. We coordinated gifts (including a watch, coffee, a coffee thermos, a Theo's gift card, and a giant check from the bank of Ke\$ha), streamers, hats, ties, balloons, a piñata, and a mariachi band; and we wrote him a departing letter in Greek. During the entire thing, I think he

laughed maybe twice. It warmed our hearts.

TBJ: Which subject have you excelled in the most?

RH: I think I've had the most success in the sciences and the Classics. Science has always been one of my favorite subjects, so it's consistently been one I've devoted myself to. Greek and Latin have been the classes that I've just loved because of the grammar and versatility of the languages. But one thing I'm really proud of in the Classics is that I finally received my Oxford Classical Dictionary for four years of gold on the National Latin Exam. I named her Laura.

TBJ: How much effort does it take to put together such events as Welcome Week, Homecoming Week, Senior Day, etc?

RH: Welcome Week and Homecoming Week are really in the works before school even starts. The E-Board goes on a retreat during the summer and discusses plans and ideas for the upcoming year. By the end, we must have discussed and decided upon our themes and events for Welcome Week and Homecoming Week. This year's discussion was pretty interesting. I believe that an Under the Sea Cowboys theme came up a few times.

TBJ: How has the E-Board this year transformed the intramural program?

RH: The intramural program's revival is due to a general direction of focus towards it by Student Council. It was brought to the E-Board's attention during our planning retreat that the intramural program was on a serious decline; so the reaction was to shift attention back to it, to bring back some older favorites such as cabbageball, and to enlist some committed referees. Mr. Orillion and James Licciardi were two of the main reasons that the intramurals program worked successfully because they worked together on the execution of a lot of these plans.

TBJ: How has Blue Jay spirit been fostered this year?

RH: Our E-Board has been really centered on trying to revive Blue Jay spirit by bringing back some of the older traditions while possibly starting some new ones.

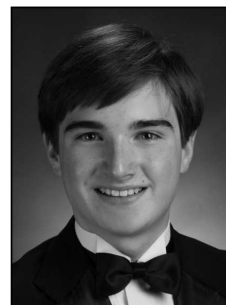
Yes we have been taught Ignatian Ideals and learned the true meaning of Men of Faith and Men for Others, but through everything we have done here we have been taught something.

Winning records top Blue Jay sports year

Jesuit High School always seems to put up competitive teams in almost every single sport in which it competes. Because of the usual success, it is no question that the students and school expect nothing less than to win all the time. However, at the end of the day, everybody knows that winning all the time is a simple impossibility.

The fall sports secured winning seasons but often had hopes cut short in post-season play. Nevertheless, they still managed some enviable feats when compared to other schools. The football team made it to the second round of the playoffs but lost in a decisive defeat in the second round to a more physically talented St. Augustine squad.

The soccer team made a sparkling run this year but lost in a close match to the St. Paul's wolves in the state semifinals.

The wrestling team finished second in the state tournament with individual titles going to Ben D'Antonio and Nicky Charles. The cross country team placed a strong third-place finish in their state meet. The rugby team also slotted a third-place finish in their state tournament. In an effort to defend several pre-

vious state titles, the Jesuit swim team fell short, taking the runner-up spot in the state competition. Finally, the basketball team lost a close one to Ruston in the first round of the state playoffs.

The spring sports did not perform too shabby themselves, picking up a few state titles along the way. The tennis team won almost every phase of the competition to gain another state championship with a standout doubles performance by Greg Suhor and Brandon Beck who won first while Jordan Lacoste took individual state runner-up.

The golf team had a strong year but a rough state tournament finishing seventh. The bowling team had their best finish yet competing in the final four of the state tournament. The lacrosse team closed the books on another wildly successful season winning another state championship. Track and field took third in district with exceptional times posted by Chris Mills and Patrick LaCour, who both qualified for state.

Two Jesuit teams are still competing for their respective titles. The sailing team has qualified for nationals. The baseball team, at press time, had recently punched its ticket to Sulphur for the state semifinals and finals. Look for final results from both teams on Jesuit's website.

From academics to spirituality, clubs show thriving student life

As another year comes to a finish at Jesuit High School, another year of memories wrap up. This year has been particularly notable in that so many student organizations have expanded and succeeded in their various fields. What better way to reflect on the year, and see that life at Jesuit extends well beyond the classroom, then to examine the hard work of Jesuit students in their co-curricular activities.

On the competitive side, Mock Trial had another outstanding year capturing first and third place at the state competition. Jesuit's first-place team, which included senior Mark Alvarez, and juniors Patrick Fine and William Tittle (attorneys), and seniors Charles Farley and Jordan Lacoste, and junior Matthew Stuckey (witnesses), won all three of their matches.

The Debate team won the State Tournament once again with first-place finishes from Jim Huang in Varsity Lincoln-Douglas (the third time he has done it!) and in Public Forum debate junior Rishab Chimmanamada, sophomore Mayank Mardia, sophomore Andrew Cerise, and junior Mako Giordano beat top rival Holy Cross to close out the finals and claim a shared state championship for the first time in Jesuit debate history.

Mu Alpha Theta had a great year at April's State Math Convention. The tournament saw competition from 31 schools throughout the state. That team effort included 64 Blue Jays.

The Quiz Bowl team, always a force to be reckoned with, defended its State National Academic Quiz Tournaments title at Tulane University on March 29. Two teams from Jesuit competed, sweeping the tournament, undefeated until the Blue Jays faced-off in the final round to claim first and second place.

Team A, composed of sen-

iors Ian Calamari and Stanley Dai, juniors Brett Loria and Sam Zelden, and senior captain Kevin Yokum, went undefeated to take first place. Yokum was also named the tournament's MVP.

On the side of socially conscious clubs, the St. Peter Claver Club had a great year discussing diversity and stopping discrimination of all kind. The Social Justice Forum has held several discussions on topics such as life issues, poverty, gun violence, and sexism in the workplace. These discussions were led by seniors and were introduced as to make Jesuit students more aware of the social justice issues of today.

The Pro-Life Club has continued its goal on campus by giving presentations, discussions, hosting a Pro-Life Week, praying at the local abortion facility, and participating in this year's national March for Life in Washington, D.C. The Club was also able to bring the Life Bus, a Louisiana Right to Life mobile facility used to help mothers receive information about their

unborn children, to

help educate the school on Pro-Life outreach.

As far as spiritual organizations go at Jesuit, Campus Ministry and Sodality have had very successful years in shaping the spiritual development of the school. Campus Ministry led both the 8th- and 9th-grade night of reflections. It also led a Lenten Renewal consisting of a school-wide Pretzel Fast and Stations of the Cross. Sodality and Campus Ministry both sponsored several speakers over the year dealing with topics like developing one's faith life and the dignity of the imprisoned.

What a year! It's truly crazy how fast a school year can go at Jesuit, especially when it is your last year. The Class of 2014 has left its mark on Jesuit High School, but for the Class of 2015, I wish for nothing but to raise the bar even higher. Our time year at Jesuit goes by quickly, and I encourage all of you to seize the day and to accomplish all that you can while here.
