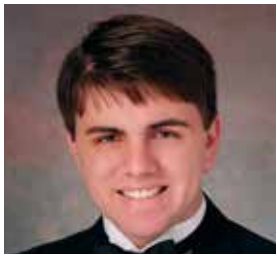

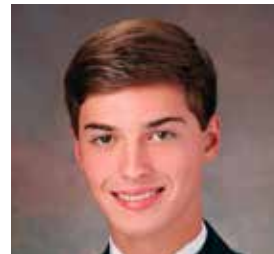

NATIONAL MERIT SEMIFINALISTS

Forty-three seniors in Jesuit High School's Class of 2016 were honored as National Merit Semifinalists — the most from any one school in the State of Louisiana — in the annual prestigious scholarship competition. Additionally, 22 Jesuit seniors were recognized as “Commended” students in the competition.

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) underwrites the program which recognizes some 16,000 Semifinalists, who represent less than one percent of U.S. high school seniors. The NMSC designates Semifinalists on a state representational basis to ensure that outstanding students from across the country are included in the talent pool. The number of Semifinalists named in each state is in proportion to its percentage of the national total of graduating seniors.

Jesuit's 43 National Merit Semifinalists represent 20% of Louisiana's 212 honorees from 52 high schools. The qualifying test scores of Blue Jay Semifinalists ranged from 211 to 234 (240 was a perfect score). The scores of “Commended” Blue Jays ranged from 202 to 210.

In the past 10 years, 339 Blue Jays have been honored as National Merit Semifinalists.

NATIONAL HISPANIC SCHOLARS

Eight seniors in Jesuit's Class of 2016 were honored as National Hispanic Scholars, including six who were among the 43 Blue Jays named as National Merit Semifinalists.

In the past 10 years, 35 Blue Jays have been recognized as National Hispanic Scholars.

The National Hispanic Recognition Program (NHRP) is sponsored by the College Board and annually recognizes about 5,000 of the 250,000 Hispanic/Latino students who take the qualifying test.

In September 2015, the NMSC and the United Negro College Fund (UNCF) announced the discontinuation of the National Achievement Scholarship Program which recognized academically talented Black American high school seniors.

Twenty Blue Jays from the Classes of 2005 through 2015 have been honored as National Achievement Semifinalists.
