PASS/FAIL

ONE-SEMESTER COURSES: Passing requires BOTH (1) a grade of at least 70 in the second marking period of the semester AND (2) an average of at least 70 for the semester.

FULL-YEAR COURSES: Passing requires BOTH (1) a grade of at least 70 in the second semester AND (2) a two-semester average of at least 70.

FAILURES must be completed in the summer session. Only TWO units of credit (two full-year courses, or one full-year course and two semester courses, or four semester courses) can be completed in the summer session. Any student who fails more than the equivalent of two units may not return to Jesuit High School the following year and may not complete his failures in our summer school. **SENIORS MUST PASS ALL SCHEDULED COURSES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR GRADUATION.**
