

# Tuition & Registration Payment Process

We are happy to inform you that First Bank and Trust and Jesuit High School in New Orleans are partnering for the management of tuition payments and financial aid processing. First Bank and Trust offers a convenient, secure online portal for the payment or financing of tuition and to apply for tuition assistance from Jesuit High School.

First and foremost, Jesuit strives to keep tuition at a level affordable to most families. Jesuit's tuition is one of the least expensive among Catholic and private high schools in the New Orleans area.

## **Basic Tuition 2021-2022 (including most fees): \$10,250**

*Tuition for 2020-2021 was \$9,950.*

*Jesuit's finance office emails tuition bills in the beginning of June and the beginning of November.*

Please be aware that Jesuit High School will be collecting a \$250 registration fee for all students beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. This will cover fees previously collected on registration day for items such as retreats, standardized test prep, graduation, planners, etc. This fee must be paid by new incoming student by March 10, 2021, and returning students by May 1, 2021 through first bank and trust tuition portal.

## **Registration, Enrichment, & Tuition Payment Process**

The following are some important facts you should know about First Bank & Trust website and your options as you prepare for the 2021-2022 school year.

**All registration, enrichment, and tuition payments must be paid through the First Bank and Trust Tuition Portal**

**Please do not mail or drop off any payments to Jesuit High School unless you are making a cash payment. No personal/business checks will be accepted at the school**

**Easy Online Sign-Up:** As a first time user of the bank's portal, you will be required to create a User ID and password by logging into <https://tuitionportal.fbtonline.com>. If you are an existing user on the portal and already have a User ID and password set up for another school, you may use the same login credentials to access your student's file for Jesuit High School.

**2021-2022 Tuition Payment Options:** The FBT web portal opened for Jesuit High School parents on Monday, March 1, 2021. You will have the following (3) payment options on the bank's secure portal to pay tuition:

**Option 1 - Pay Tuition in Full by July 1, 2021**

**Option 2 - Pay Tuition in (2) payment installments (\$5,125.00/semester): Due July 1<sup>st</sup> and December 1<sup>st</sup>**

**Option 3 - Finance Full or Partial Tuition with an FBT tuition loan  
(deadline for a 10 month loan is May 24, 2021)**

**Note:** For Options 1 and 2, payments may be made with a one-time bank draft (using your bank's routing number and account number) or with a credit or debit card. There is no added fee for payments made using a bank draft, however if you use a credit or debit card to pay tuition for Options 1 or 2, there is a 2.99% convenience fee added to the amount being charged on the card.

**Financing Option and Loan Terms (Low Interest Rate):** If you choose to finance tuition, you must set up a (10) month tuition loan no later than Monday, May 24, 2021. Shorter term loans will result in higher monthly payments. The annual percentage rate on the tuition loan for Jesuit High School is 3.0%. There is no pre-payment penalty if you decide to pay the loan off early. In addition, there is no credit check required for the borrower(s). Your ten-month tuition loan will advance on June 1, 2021 and monthly payments will start in July 2021. First Bank and Trust will assess an annual fee of \$35.00 if you choose to finance tuition. This fee is billed once your loan is funded. There is no fee if you pay tuition in full using a one-time bank draft with your bank's routing number and account number. **For those who have applied for financial aid, results will not be available until early June at which time your loan amount will be reduced by the amount of financial aid you're receiving.**

**Convenient Automatic Payments:** If you choose to finance tuition, you will be required to set up automatic bank drafts for the monthly payments. You may choose a payment due date of the 3<sup>rd</sup> or the 17<sup>th</sup> of the month. A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for any returned payment. An additional \$15.00 late fee will be assessed if the returned payment results in a late payment.

# FINANCIAL AID – 2021-2022 School Year

Jesuit High School of New Orleans is partnering with First Bank and Trust, to process online financial aid applications for parents applying for tuition assistance. First Bank and Trust provides a secure, online, independent financial analysis to assist Jesuit families in determining financial aid eligibility.

*The primary requisite for receiving a financial aid scholarship is the family's inability to pay full tuition.*

You may begin the online process of filing for financial aid by going to <https://tuitionportal.fbtonline.com> to set up your User Id and Password on the First Bank and Trust portal. If you are already set up as a “user” on the portal, you may use your existing ID and password.

From the Dashboard, click on the “Financial Aid Tab”, then click on the “First Bank and Trust Partner Schools” link.

From the “Start” page, begin completing all fields and sections of the application that apply to your family.

## **You will need the following information to Complete Your Application:**

1. Copy of your signed most recent federal form 1040 income tax return with all W-2's
2. Copies of two (2) most recent employment paystubs for all applicants
3. Copy of your most recent Unemployment Compensation Statement of Benefits (if applicable)
4. Copies of all non-taxable income documentation (Social Security and Disability Income)
5. Documentation of Monthly Rental Expense (If applicable)
6. Court Orders showing alimony, child support, and any financial agreements

From the “Documentation” page, you will be required to upload the required documents through a secure online process. Documents may also be faxed to First Bank and Trust to the attention of “Financial Aid Processing” at (504) 620-1450.

Once you submit your online application, you will receive a confirmation email from FBT. If additional information or documentation is required, you will be contacted by a bank representative at the email address or phone number provided.

Once the review of your application has been completed, your information will be forwarded to the school for a final determination in awarding tuition assistance and you will be notified by the school of the results of your application. You will not receive tuition assistance results from First Bank and Trust.
