Re: Information about **Jesuit High School Uniforms**

The school uniform consists of the following:

1. Uncuffed, unpleated, neat, and clean dress khaki pants (Pants are to be worn around the natural waist);
2. A short- or long-sleeved, clean, and neat khaki shirt with flaps on pockets (Shirt must be tucked in and belt must be visible.);
3. The official, sanctioned Jesuit sleeve patch sewn on the **left** sleeve with the top of the patch one-fourth of an inch below the shoulder seam (Patches are available at the Blue Jay Shop and from the Volunteer Coordinator only.);
4. A school-issued nametag worn over the top of the right pocket (available at Book Sale Days in August);
5. A khaki web belt;
6. Black dress socks; and
7. Shined, plain black, military shoes (smooth-soled) in good condition and properly worn. Heels should be less than 1½” thick, and soles less than 1” thick. (“Doc” Martens and similar thick-soled shoes are not permitted.) If school shoes need to be repaired, other dress shoes should be worn. Athletic shoes are not appropriate for school wear.

Students are not allowed to wear 100% cotton pants or shirts. Jesuit suggests Dickey's brand (or a comparable brand) khaki pants and shirts that are available at many stores in the area.

No undergarment that extends beyond the sleeves of the khaki shirt can be worn under short-sleeved shirts. Only white shirts may be worn under the khaki shirt. During cooler weather, the following guidelines apply:

1. If the garment opens all the way down the front, it will be referred to as a **jacket**, and it must be plain (one solid color (blue, black, white or grey without a logo) or Jesuit-imprinted. (Denim, military-style, hunting, poncho-type, leather, suede, or the like are not permitted.);
2. If it does not open all the way down the front and pulls over the head, it will be referred to as a **pullover**, and it must be issued by Jesuit High School of New Orleans.

**Please note:** The only imprints allowed on **any** outerwear are Jesuit imprints.

Uniforms and/or shoes may be purchased from many stores in the area. While Jesuit High School does not endorse any particular outlet, the following stores are listed for your convenience: Haase's Shoe Store (New Orleans), J & L Uniforms (Terrytown), Perret's Army Stores (Kenner), Ponseti's Shoes (Metairie), Schiro's Shoes and Uniforms (Metairie), Schumacher's Shoes and Uniforms (Metairie), Skobelj's (Belle Chasse), Uniformity School & Work (Marrero), Uniforms by Kajan (Kenner, Marrero, Metairie), and Young Fashions (Metairie).
