NATIONAL MERIT SEMIFINALISTS

Thirty-five seniors in Jesuit High School's Class of 2018 were honored as National Merit Semifinalists in the annual prestigious scholarship competition. Additionally, 19 Jesuit seniors were recognized as "Commended" students in the competition.

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) underwrites the program which recognizes some 15,000 Semifinalists, who represent less than one percent of U.S. high school seniors. The NMSC designates Semifinalists on a state representational basis to ensure that outstanding students from across the country are included in the talent pool. The number of Semifinalists named in each state is in proportion to its percentage of the national total of graduating seniors.

Jesuit's 35 National Merit Semifinalists represent 16% of Louisiana's 212 honorees from 57 high schools. The 2018 qualifying test score was 216. Scores for Blue Jay Semifinalists ranged from 217 to 228. The scores of "Commended" Blue Jays ranged from 211 to 215.

In the past 12 years, 396 Blue Jays have been honored as National Merit Semifinalists.

NATIONAL HISPANIC SCHOLARS

Five seniors in Jesuit's Class of 2018 were honored as National Hispanic Scholars, including four who were among the 35 Blue Jays named as National Merit Semifinalists.

In the past 12 years, 46 Blue Jays have been recognized as National Hispanic Scholars.

The National Hispanic Recognition Program (NHRP) is sponsored by the College Board and annually recognizes about 5,000 of the 250,000 Hispanic/Latino students who take the qualifying test.
