# **BULLETIN REVIEW**

Please read and become familiar with the school *Bulletin*. This document contains important information that will play a key role as you develop and move towards graduation from Jesuit High School. The *Bulletin* focuses not only on general issues (calendar; history, philosophy) but also Jesuit's overall objectives (school policies, programs of studies, and school organizations). The section on Student Conduct will be important to you on a day-to-day basis. Please pay special attention to this section so that you will know exactly what is expected of you—in particular, but not limited to: unforeseen absence from school (p50), late arrival to school (p51), hair (p54), academic dishonesty (p63), penance hall (p64), major offenses (p65), and sanctions (p66). The guidelines outlined in this section are not meant to be comprehensive; they presuppose good will and good judgment on the part of the student and his parents.

By signing this form, both students and parents agree they have read and understood, and they will comply with the school regulations and policies set forth in the Bulletin and elsewhere, and that they will be responsible for any duties, including but not limited to payment of tuition, set forth therein. In order to compensate teachers and maintain campus facilities, Jesuit relies on tuition paid in a timely manner. Specifically, parents and legal guardians herein agree, pursuant to the policies set forth in the Bulletin and elsewhere, to pay the tuition assessed for their student in the manner required by Jesuit. Parents and legal guardians further acknowledge and agree that failure to pay a student's tuition in the manner required by Jesuit may result in suspension or expulsion of the student, or other disciplinary and/or legal actions, in Jesuit's sole discretion.

## THE HONOR CODE

More than merely an academic institution, Jesuit High School seeks to form young men of "competence, conscience, and compassion."

The honor code at Jesuit High School is a statement of positive attitudes and behaviors designed to instill in students the responsibility and self-discipline that will maintain respect for God, fellow students, teachers, and themselves.
