

Remote Learning Policies for School Closures (STUDENTS):

Asynchronous Learning

In the event of school closure due to inclement weather, power outages, or other emergencies, the school may continue academic and operational functions remotely. The policies listed here provide students and faculty with basic expectations that may be adjusted to meet the unique challenges of a given closure.

At Home Learning Policy for Students: Asynchronous Learning

Policy Purpose: These procedures are designed to minimize the negative impact on learning due to school closure.

Device Readiness

1. Students are responsible for obtaining and using a device that is fully functional for academic work.
2. Students must have reliable access to the Internet for all required Student Portal applications.

Asynchronous Learning General Guidelines

1. **Assignment Access:** Students will have access to teacher assignments on the Canvas calendar by 9:00 AM each asynchronous learning day.
 2. **Student Responsibilities:**
 - Check Canvas calendar daily for new assignments and updates
 - Complete all posted assignments by their specified deadlines
 - If required, submit work as designated by the teacher
 - Monitor Canvas for email about important updates
 3. **Assignment Deadlines:** All assignment due dates and times will be clearly posted. Students are expected to meet these deadlines unless prior arrangements have been made with individual teachers.
 4. **Communication:** Students should use Canvas messaging or school email to communicate with teachers regarding assignments or clarifications.
