DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE JESUIT CURRICULUM

Placement

4 academic programs based on the student's entrance exam results and elementary school performance.

Course Selection

The student's program determines the courses available to him.

Technology

Personal electronic devices are prohibited to protect appropriate social development and classroom attention. Teachers employ instructional technology and utilize the learning management system, Canvas, for posting and receiving assignments online.

Five-Year Theology Requirement

Intensive theology curriculum rooted in philosophy, ethics, morality, history, social justice, and sacred scripture.

AP Limits

Jesuit's Classical education requiring extensive coursework in theology and languages limits AP offerings.

Extensive Foreign Language Requirement

All students must complete at least 3 credits in the same foreign language. The most advanced students must complete at least 7 credits in 2 foreign languages, one of which must be Latin.
